## Notice of Annual General Meeting

The Annual General Meeting of the Friends of Kings Norton Nature Reserve (FKNNR) will be held on Monday, 15<sup>th</sup> May 2017 at Kings Norton Bowling Club, Wychall Lane, Road, Kings Norton, commencing at 7.30 p.m.

Business to be conducted will include the following matters:-

- To receive the Chairman's Report, and the Treasurer's Report and Accounts for the year ended 31<sup>st</sup> March 2017
- To consider Membership Subscriptions for the year 2017/18
- Election of Honorary Officers and Members to the Executive Committee ("the Friends Committee")
  - (a) Election to the positions of Chairman, Vice Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer, and Membership Secretary for a term of two years expiring 2019
  - (b) Election to three vacancies of Ordinary Member for a term of three years expiring 2020
- To consider appointments to the posts of Education Liaison Officer and Volunteer Co-ordinator for a term of two years expiring 2019
- Election of an Independent Examiner for the accounts of the FKNNR

Nominations are particularly invited for the posts of Secretary and Membership Secretary since the present post holders have indicated that they do not propose to stand for re-election.**

At the conclusion of the business, there will be a short talk by Steve Hinton, Senior Ranger of Birmingham City Council, on the development of the Nature Reserve. There will also be the opportunity to discuss with members of the Friends Committee any matters relating to the Nature Reserve and its future development.
